6. Headteacher's report

• Headteacher to meet with Dave Barber from Ebor Academy Trust, they are offering free associate membership for 1 year. Currently we are with North Star Alliance at a cost of £1000 per year (included in budget). We currently have an issue with travel time & costs and feel that NSA are no longer offering value for money. We are currently part of the Selby Learning Alliance which includes 16 schools and offers school to school support. We also receive English & Maths network meetings through Dfe. Governors agree it would be good to consider all options

 A No we want to achieve these targets that is why we are employing an additional outstanding teacher

- 3. Maintain and strengthen Good judgement of school
 - To ensure that school is solidly good in all areas
 - Progress data & end of year data will link into this
 - Monitoring is important and needs to be increased by Governors
 - To monitor areas & subjects to be added to strategic plan

 - New toilets & cloakrooms are essential
 - All areas of school are currently used as teaching areas
 - Q Could we get a small portacabin?
 - A We would need planning permission plus facilities and electricity
